- A. She was unclothed--upper body was unclothed, and she had dungarees, jeans, I believe, on the bottom part of her body.
 - Q. Do you recall whether her jeans were buttoned or snapped at the waist or not?
 - A. I don't recall.

- O. What was Mr. Broom wearing?
- A. Mr. Broom was wearing jeans, as I recall, and I do not believe he had a shirt on.
 - Q. Do you recall whether he had any shoes on?
 - A. I don't -- he didn't have shoes on.
 - Q. What injuries did you observe to the deceased?
- A. There was quite a bit of blood about her head, consequently it was difficult to tell where, what we believed an entry wound was. We did get a call it was a shooting and naturally we assumed it was a shooting, and it was very difficult for me to determine where the entry of any type of bullet could have gone. Her hair was matted somewhat with blood as was her face.
- Q. What did you and the other officers do then as you or after you entered the room?
- A. I immediately--well, we called for emergency medical technicians. I was still unsure of what the situation was.

 Normally, in a situation like this--I say normally, at this particular time with the defendant still being there, I



surmised it possibly could have been a suicide.

(The attorneys left the bench. Mr. Pickard conferred with the witness.)

Q. So that you will understand what we are doing at this point, there are certain areas of information that are--should not properly be presented to you for any one of a number of reasons, and we are attempting now to advise the witness that in response to a particular question, he is not to volunteer anything beyond that which is responsive to the question
